### ORDER 20.08.2022

1. Assam Power Generation Corporation Ltd. (APGCL) filed a petition for amendment of Regulation 51.2(a) of the AERC (terms and Conditions for determination of MYT) Regulations, 2021 on Normative O & M cost of 98.4 MW NRPP.
2. The Petition was registered as Petition No. 03/ 2022.
3. The Petitioner submitted that the new NRPP plant have advanced F Class Machines. They mentioned that, these Machines require extra care and precautions for sustaining high level of availability of the station and maintain higher efficiency. Therefore, APGCL prayed to the Commission to escalate the figures of the FY 2021-22 to arrive at the new figure for the MYT Control period from FY 2022-23 to FY 2024-25.
4. The Commission conducted a hearing on 18.07.2022 at the Office of the Commission. The Petitioner was present.
5. Having heard the Petitioner and considering the submissions on record, the Commission asked APGCL to submit the certain clarifications.
6. APGCL submitted the information on 5<sup>th</sup> August 2022.
7. After scrutinizing the Petition and related information submitted by APGCL, the Commission noted that the figures submitted by APGCL are estimations only. The Commission is of the view that in absence of actual O & M cost (Audited), it may not be prudent to revise the norms only on the basis of submissions of APGCL.
8. However, APGCL is at liberty to place their claim at the time of true up with proper documentary evidence during the control period from FY 2022-23 to FY 2024-25 based on the audited data of O & M expenses and the Commission shall decide on the basis of the actual audited data.
9. With the above observations and views, the Petition No 03/2022 is disposed off.
